- Maintain an attendance rate of at least 95% across the school by working closely with students, families and external agencies, when applicable, to ensure all students are engaged and remain engaged in learning.
- Establish a proactive, supportive and engaging learning environment that compliments the rigorous teaching and learning systems so that 100% of students are achieving an A-C in English.
- Identify and case-manage 100% of the diverse learners within the school.


## Our initiatives include

- Supporting students within their classroom through a co-teaching model that is inclusive and responsive to students with diverse learning needs.
- Establishing a case-management approach for diverse learners through Student Intervention Meetings (SIM) and Complex Case Management (CCM).
- Establishing a Positive PB4L committee that is focused on exemplary practices to promote positive behaviour at our school.
- Implementing a Social and Emotional Learning (SELs) program aligned to the Personal and Social capabilities of the Australian Curriculum.
- Engaging students in their learning through the use of ICTs, Coding and Robotics, STEAM integration and a Sustainability precinct that encourages entrepreneurialism.
