



Nirimba State Primary School Representation Policy

Commencement: 27 July 2026

Review Year: 2027

Purpose

The Nirimba State Primary School Representation Policy outlines the expectations for representing Nirimba State Primary School in non-curriculum related events. It aims to ensure that all students maintain appropriate behaviour, attendance and engagement aligned to our Nirimba State Primary School Student Code of Conduct up to representing the school in an identified non-curriculum event.

Rationale

Students who represent Nirimba State Primary School serve as ambassadors for the school and are expected to demonstrate the school's values both on and off campus. Selection to represent the school is considered a privilege that recognises students' skills, commitment and positive contribution to the school community.

Scope

- Year Levels: Year 4 – 6
- Non-curriculum events and competitions.

Student Expectations for Representation at Non-Curriculum Events

- Maintain satisfactory attendance 85%+
- Maintain **satisfactory behaviour** aligned to the Nirimba State Primary School Code of Conduct. Specifically:
 - No School Disciplinary Absence (SDA) **within five weeks** of the scheduled non-curriculum event.
 - No more than three recorded major behaviour incidences **within five weeks** of the scheduled non-curriculum event.

A student who does not demonstrate satisfactory attendance and/or behaviour will have their participation in a non-curriculum event reviewed. A decision on whether a student is ineligible to attend an event or competition will be made in consideration of student expectations with individual circumstances taken in account, where appropriate.

Application of Representation Policy

Student selection and participation in non-curriculum activities will be reviewed on an individual case-by-case basis. Non-curriculum-based activities include but are not limited to:

- District sporting trials and competitions (all sports)
- Participation in District or Regional sporting activities i.e. District Athletics, Cross-Country or Swimming etc.
- Inter-school sports (Year 5 & 6)
- School Camps (Day or Overnight)
- Surf Skills
- Participation Arts competitions i.e. Dance X, Eisteddfods etc.
- Participation in Opti Minds

School Responsibilities

- Monitor student attendance and behaviour.
- Support student behaviour and attendance in collaboration and communication with parents and carers.
- The school's decision regarding ineligibility will be final and communicated to a parent or carer.
- Where an event or competition has required payment, all money paid by the parent or carer will be refunded in full.
